FLOOR AMENDMENT NO.\_\_\_\_\_

Amend C.S.H.B. No. 3948 (senate committee report) by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the bill and renumbering the SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

4 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Section 41.002(1), Agriculture Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 (1) "Agricultural commodity" means an agricultural, 7 horticultural, viticultural, or vegetable product, bees and honey, 8 planting seed, rice, <u>hemp</u>, livestock or livestock product, or 9 poultry or poultry product, produced in this state, either in its 10 natural state or as processed by the producer. The term does not 11 include flax.

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 141.008, Agriculture Code, is amended to read as follows:

14 Sec. 141.008. HEMP IN COMMERCIAL FEED. <u>(a)</u> The service 15 <u>shall</u> [may] adopt rules authorizing, defining, and controlling the 16 use of hemp and hemp products in commercial feed.

17 (b) Rules adopted under this section must authorize the use 18 of hemp as commercial feed or an ingredient or component of 19 commercial feed for:

20 (1) pets, specialty and exotic pets, horses, and other 21 animals that are not intended for human consumption or for the 22 production of animal byproducts intended for human consumption; and 23 (2) only to the extent authorized by the United States 24 Food and Drug Administration, animals that are intended for human 25 consumption or for the production of animal byproducts intended for 26 human consumption.
